CAFOD Fast Day Lent Appeal: Last week parishes across the country donated to the 2019 Lent Appeal, in aid of families suffering from hunger and the impact of climate change. The CTK Justice & Peace Group also organized a frugal Sunday lunch in solidarity with those families. The children made a lovely **display of Lent promises** which can be seen in the hall. Including Gift Aid, **CTK parishioners donated £918.93** to the Appeal. This will enable CAFOD to help people become more resilient to the effects of climate change by building 5 protected ponds full of fish, or by teaching 17 people a trade for life.
