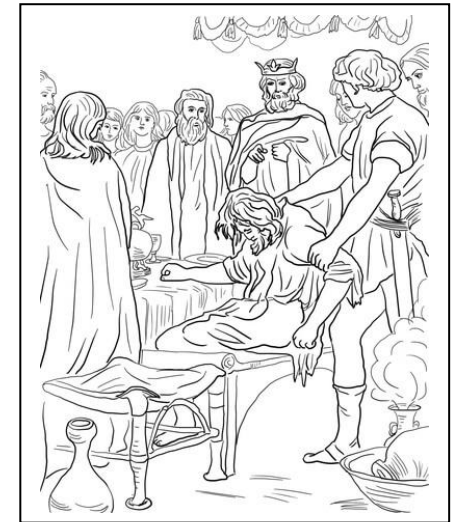

**CONFIRMATION:** Due to Coronavirus restrictions the preparation sessions for our Confirmation Candidates were interrupted and then completed 'online'.
