

HOPE FOR OUR COMMON HOME – An Opportunity for Reflection:

A big thankyou to all those who attended the online 'taster' session on Tuesday evening, arranged for us by Jesuit Missions, following on from our very successful Parish Mission last year. The session was both enjoyable and thought provoking, and included an interview with Fr Paul who lives and works in Georgetown, Guyana. The aim was to explore the dignity of the human person, the common good and solidarity in the context of the work of the Jesuit Missions. There was also an Ignatian contemplation after which we were invited to share our thoughts both personally and as a parish. **We have all been asked to support the efforts of the Jesuit Missions to free Fr Stan Swamy SJ, 83,** a Jesuit priest and human rights activist, who was arrested unjustly by India's National Investigation Agency for alleged links to terrorism.
