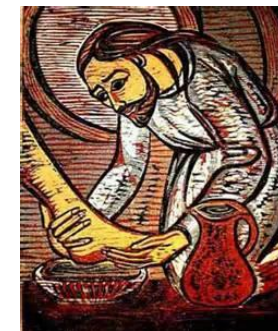

All prisoners go out on the exercise yards in just a track suit, but no-one has a coat. It means the exercise yards are very cold, especially for those with thinning or short hair.
