**GOOD NEWS.** The bishops of England and Wales have said that Catholics should return to Mass from **THIS** weekend Pentecost. “the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply”. Please pass this message to those who may not have heard it.

**MORE GOOD NEWS** – Our Parish QR CODE, (on the back page), is now working and so is one Card Payment Machine at the back of the church. Both can be used to make your contributions to First & Second Collections.

**THANK YOU – for your generosity to the recent Annual Mission Appeal which, this year, was for the Comboni Missionaries.** As a parish we donated a total of **£851.15.** Over half of this amount was made using the card payment machines and the QR code. For your interest breakdown as follows:  
Cash Donations: £372.40 (Gift Aid on cash donations £13.75)  
Contactless Donations: £380.00 (Gift Aid on contactless donations £85.00).  
You can see from these figures what a huge benefit the contactless options are – especially when Gift Aided! So, if you have not yet used the machine or QR code, please do give it a go. It really is so easy to use and so is the option of Gift Aiding your donations. The parish or other charities will receive an extra 25% at no extra cost to you!
