**CTK DEPAUL UKRAINE APPEAL - UPDATE:** Our Depaul Ukraine parish appeal will remain open on an ongoing basis. As Depaul's Mark McGreevy has said: “While the war continues, the need for humanitarian aid will continue to grow, and even sustaining our current levels of 80-100 tonnes per week will be no mean feat. But we are also starting to plan what comes next. We know that people will need significant help to deal with the effects of trauma, financial and practical support for those who have lost their homes, help with employment and benefits, legal assistance for those who have lost all their identity documents, and so much more.
