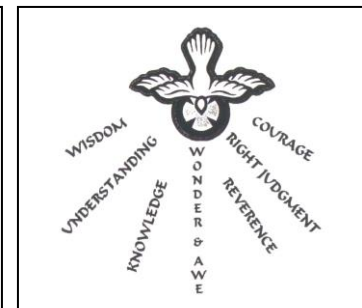

RESULTS OF THE RECENT PARISH FINANCE APPEAL: Great news!

Thank you very much to all who have responded so far to the financial appeal made by Margaret Pedder in mid-April. The results are:

STANDING ORDERS:

- 10 standing order donors increased their monthly contributions. A total value of additional monthly funds is £445.00
- 4 new standing orders have been set-up which will provide an additional £55.00 per month

So, in total our monthly donations have increased by £500.00 (445+55) per month.

GIFT AID:

- 12 people signed up to join the Gift Aid scheme, primarily through the contactless machines.

The increase in monthly standing orders (£500) is mostly from Gift Aid donors. £475.00 will be subject to Gift Aid.
