**NEW TENANT FOR OUR HALL:** We are pleased to announce that the Pony & Panda Bilingual Education (Mandarin/English) Nursery will be starting with a Summer School on 12 August and then as a full-time nursery (Mon-Fri) from September. They have begun the planned work/changes to their section of the garden which will be levelled, with a playground surface to create an area suitable for outdoor play. Meanwhile our own contractor, Jason, has made a start on preparing the floor in the hall lobby area and some of the hall toilets for new flooring. We hope that all of the works will be completed by 12 August. **PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT, AS OF THIS MON 29 JULY, THE HALL AND SIDE LOBBY/ENTRANCE TO THE CHURCH WILL BE OUT OF BOUNDS UNTIL COMPLETION OF THE NEW FLOORING.** More updates to follow.

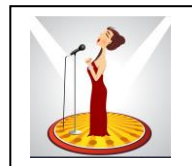
