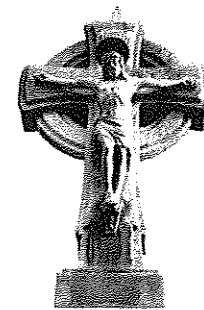

**CHILDREN'S LITURGY:** For the past forty years or so in the life of the Church there has been an encouragement to provide Children's Liturgy during Mass. This means that young children are invited to go somewhere out of the Church and hear the readings of the Mass explained in a more child friendly way, then returning to join the rest of the Congregation at the time of the collection and offertory. We have been very grateful that at Christ the King we have been able to provide this service for many years. Our deepest gratitude to all who have been part of this, past and present. In the past recent months, we have been blessed that many new young families have joined our parish family, some of whom may not be aware that we have a Children's Liturgy. Children are invited to come forward to collect the book they use from the priest and process to our parish hall. This takes place right at the very beginning of Mass. If any child is late, please let them come anyway.

Just to clarify, the age of the children are from 4 (Reception Class at School) to 8 (Year 3 of School). This happens only during term time when schools are open.

What we would especially be grateful for is for new adult volunteers to join the team of people to create a rota to take turns to lead the Children's Liturgy. No experience is necessary – a book is provided to read from and follow. Naturally, Safeguarding Application will be required. If this is something that you believe you could help with, maybe once a month, then please let Canon Liam via his email.

**SECOND COLLECTION this weekend is for DAY FOR LIFE:** This is the day in the Church's life dedicated to celebrating the sacredness of life. The proceeds of this collection provide core funding to assist other life-related activities supported by the Church.
